1	AUT	MPsychotherapy	MU suggested that paper 589874 Research for Psychotherapy was inappropriately named. AUT agreed to reconsider the title.	Yes
2	Waikato	BEP	AU, MU and LU thought the proposal lacked coherence in its planning content. WU changed an elective paper to a compulsory one and made other adjustments to its proposed offering.	Yes
3	Massey	GradDipArts	Through careful reading of the regs AU noted some confusion between an endorsed and an unendorsed diploma. MU acknowledged the lack of clarity and proposed an amendment. AU also pointed out a small typographical error.	No
4	Massey	MCW	Both AU and WU suggested that the admission regulation was rather restrictive. MU agreed and rewrote the regulation.	No
5	Victoria	PGDipClinRes	MU suggested that a focus on behavioural psychology was too narrow a focus for a prerequisite to a clinical research diploma. VUW agreed to remove the word "behavioural."	No
6	Otago	BAppSc, BAppSc(Hons) Analytical and Forensic Science	There was much correspondence about the nature of forensic science. CU suggested the title be changed to "Forensic Analytical Science." OU eventually agreed to make this change.	Yes
