No.	University	Proposal	Nature of amendment	Proposal to be discussed by CUAP
1	Massey	18 MU/10 BSc, BScHons, MSc/1	CU pointed out an error in no. 3 of the majoring requirements: '200-level' should read '300-level'. It also made suggestions for amendments to achieve further clarity. MU thanked CU and made appropriate changes.	Yes
2	Massey	DipEd for Support Workers	AU and OU noted that paper 186.285 was listed as both compulsory and elective. MU acknowledged and confirmed that it was compulsory and would be removed from the list of electives.	No
3	Victoria	MEd/1, PGDip EdPD/1, PGCert EdPD/1	AU pointed out that the waiver in the admission regulation (reg. 1(b)) did not require candidates to have completed a research methods paper as required for all other candidates. VUW acknowledged the oversight and amended the regulation.	No
4	Canterbury	BSpC, BTchLn (EC), (Primary), DipTchLn(EC), GradDipTchLn (EC), (Primary), (Secondary)/2	AUT pointed out that some references and grammar in the proposed new note were faulty and suggested changes. CU suggested other amendments which did not satisfy AUT. CU then changed the note to a form of words that was acceptable to AUT.	No
5	Canterbury	BEd(PhysEd)	MU suggested that CU should require a B average from students seeking to enrol in the honours programme. It also thought that allowing students to complete under the previous regulations until 2020 was too long a period. CU agreed and amended the regulations to require a B average. The reference to 2020 was changed to 2015.	No
