(Study Scholarships for Graduates of All Disciplines)

The scholarships offered by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) are awarded to advanced students, young higher education graduates, excellent scientists and academics from all fields of science and humanities as well as from the fields of music and art.

Candidates must hold a Bachelors degree of a high standard. Candidates are generally preferred to give evidence of an adequate knowledge of the German language. Exceptions are possible when scholarship holders are enrolled in international degree courses, which are given in English. (A language course may be available in Germany for those scholarship holders who have had no opportunity to acquire an adequate knowledge of German in their own countries.)

Value

Each scholarship provides for the following:

- (a) A monthly allowance which is dependent on the candidate's academic qualifications;
- (b) Travel allowance;
- (c) A study fee allowance of up to €500 per semester if study fees apply.
