

## PUKEHOU POUTU SCHOLARSHIP

The money for this scholarship has been made available by a bequest from the estate of Edith Fraser who wished that it be used for an award in agricultural or silvicultural sciences.

The scholarship shall be known as the Pukehou Poutu Scholarship and one award shall be offered each year.

The scholarship shall be tenable in any university in New Zealand for postgraduate study in either agricultural science or silvicultural science.

### *Eligibility*

Applicants must be graduates of a New Zealand university and be New Zealand citizens.

### *Value and Tenure*

The scholarship will be tenable for a period of one year and be of such an amount as Universities New Zealand from time to time will decide, having regard to the income available for the purpose (the current value is \$10,000 per annum).

### *Reports*

Every scholar shall furnish to Universities New Zealand such reports (if any) as that Committee shall require.

### *Co-Tenure*

Every scholar shall be required to devote their whole time during the tenure of the scholarship to the approved programme, and may not hold a position of emolument except on such terms and conditions as Universities New Zealand may from time to time determine.

### *Applications*

Application in the first instance should be made to the Scholarships Office at the university at which the applicant is enrolled not later than the first day in October, on the form provided by Universities New Zealand.

Every application shall be accompanied by:

- a) Signed Universities New Zealand Privacy declaration;
- b) Certified copy of birth certificate and proof of New Zealand citizenship;
- c) Certified copy of academic record;
- d) Statement outlining proposed course of study;
- e) Statement outlining the candidate's present extracurricular activities and any other particulars that may prove useful to the selection committee.

Candidates should also provide the names of two persons from whom confidential references have been requested.

No scholarship shall be awarded if, in the opinion of Universities New Zealand, there is no candidate of sufficient merit applying.

The selection committee's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into following the selection meeting.

#### *Termination*

Universities New Zealand shall have power to terminate any such scholarship and the emoluments hereunder at any time if it is not satisfied with the work or the conduct of the scholar.

#### *Power to Vary*

Universities New Zealand shall at any time and from time to time make, amplify, vary or rescind any rules or regulations which it may deem necessary or desirable for the purpose of facilitating the award of the said scholarship or in any other way giving better effect to the purpose of the said bequest, provided that such rules and regulations shall not be inconsistent with the general purpose of the said bequest or with the conditions specified in the above clauses or other conditions for the time being relating to the said scholarship and the award and tenure thereof.
